Evaluation Methods Used: HeinOnline was evaluated using a combination of automated and manual accessibility testing techniques. Automated testing using the Siteimprove Accessibility Checker was used to help identify potential accessibility issues within page structure and code. Manual testing included keyboard-only navigation to verify that interactive elements and site functionality are operable without the use of a mouse. Screen reader testing was performed using JAWS 2026 to assess accessibility of page structure, headings, links, form controls, and other interactive components for users who rely on assistive technologies. Color contrast was evaluated using a color contrast analysis tool to ensure that text and user interface elements meet the contrast requirements defined by WCAG 2.2 Level A and AA. Testing was performed using Google Chrome version 146 on Windows 11.
